Dr. Andrew Jones completed his sponsored travels throughout France bringing new insights and advanced techniques back to his patients, colleagues and community.

Jones will present his findings from the fellowship at the American College of Phlebology annual meeting.

“Hands on, international collaboration is invaluable experience,” said Jones. “The award is an opportunity for surgeons like myself to enhance their range of knowledge of the technical aspects to their speciality. The de Groot fellowship is an international award bestowed by the American College of Phlebology. The goal of the fellowship is to develop international collaborations between vein specialists, and allow for the exchange of ideas about cutting edge venous disease topics and techniques. The award is an international traveling fellowship given to one individual in the United States per year. Dr. Jones’ travels included meetings with seven vein specialists throughout France. One such meeting was with Dr. JJ Guex, world-renowned expert in sclerotherapy and author of many books about venous disease.
